RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- The Coordinator of Liturgical Music serves the parish as the **4:30 pm Saturday mass** musician, organist and choir director according to the highest professional standards established by this profession.
- Provides service by playing the piano/organ for the 4:30 pm Saturday mass. Recruits members for choir, trains, directs and supervises the choir and the cantors. Prepares assembly for liturgies through rehearsals prior to liturgies, rehearsals with choir members on Thursdays from 7:00 to 8:00 pm.
- Maintains and develops personal and professional musical skills. Attends in-service training opportunities. Sharpens skills through personal practice.
- Cooperates with the liturgical music projects of the parish in coordination with Pastor and Liturgical Committee when necessary.
- It is preferred that the candidate be available to help train the Spanish choirs on a monthly basis to promote musical improvement.
- Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Candidate must have a high degree of proficiency in the use of a keyboard and organ instruments as attested to by formal credentials and personal performance audition.
- Should have a working knowledge of other instruments, which might be used.
- Must have skill as an effective choral conductor as demonstrated by formal credentials and/or a choral audition (rehearsal)
- Must have a knowledge and appreciation of the Church's liturgical tradition as well as current liturgical practice.
- Must have an effective knowledge of quality repertoire available for liturgical music programs for adult and children's choir, organ and congregation.
- Bachelor's Level: A Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Music Degree in music performance or music education, or Colleague's Certificate (CAGO) and the Choir Master's Certificate (CMAGO) in the American Guild of Organists.
- Regular weekend work hours are required from 3:30 – 5:30 pm. Along with the regular parish liturgical schedule; musicians may be required to provide music for additional services during Holy Week, sacramental celebrations. Weddings, Quinceanera masses and funerals are optional and completely separate from this position. As opposed to additional services, they may also be informed of cancellations of their regular mass
- This position requires experience in parish liturgical music programs.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Includes but not limited to considerable use of arms and legs, whole body movement, walking, lifting 30 lbs., and stooping, standing, sitting, lifting and carrying, pushing, pulling, kneeling, crouching, crawling, hearing speaking, seeing, reaching, repetitive forward bending, repetitive arm/hand motions, prolonged gripping of an item repetitive hand/finger movements, sense of touch/feel, temperature extremes.
