

COORDINATOR OF CONFIRMATION MINISTRY

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- Plan, develop and implement events and activities related to service, social, and spiritual development of youths.
- Engage, and evangelize students and parents/guardians to pursue faith formation and become active in parish life.
- Prepare annual budget and calendar of events and adhere to those plans.
- Coordinate confirmation ministry participation in Youth Day.
- Ensure the recording of Confirmation sacraments in church register.
- Recruit, train and supervise volunteers to engage and lead students in compliance with Safe Environment policies.
- Maintain a liaison with vicariate and diocesan organizations to ensure ministry participation in diocesan events.
- Have familiarity with a variety of Catholic liturgical practice, and the use of music in worship.
- Be knowledgeable in computer communications and internet.
- Recruit and maintain catechists and catechist's aids for confirmation classes.
- Prepare confirmation lesson plans in collaboration with CRE and keep records of student attendance and progress.
- Coordinate with diocesan annual confirmation ceremonies.
- Keep track of Safe Environment requirements for catechists and aides.
- Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATION GUIDELINES:

- Must be a practicing Catholic and fully participate in sacramental life.
- Bachelor's degree in Theology, or Religious Education or a related field.
- Strong communication skills; conflict resolution skills; organizational, planning, and implementation skills; interpersonal and collaborative skills.
- Previous working experience with confirmation students, youth and parents/guardians.
- Must be able to delegate responsibilities and train and supervise volunteers.
- Must have proficiency in email/internet, and computer software such as M/S Office systems (Word, Outlook, Calendar; excel, PowerPoint, and Publisher) and social media (Facebook, twitter, etc.).
- Must be able to communicate effectively with young people and parents.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Includes but not limited to considerable use of arms and legs, whole body movement, walking, lifting, and stooping, standing, sitting, lifting and carrying 30+ lbs., pushing, pulling, kneeling, crouching, crawling, hearing, speaking, seeing, reaching, repetitive forward bending, repetitive arm/hand motions, prolonged gripping of an item, repetitive hand/finger movements, sense of touch/feel, temperature extremes.
