- Supervise student activities as requested by Administrator.
- Responsible for the organization, order, discipline and supervision of the students in his/her class and jointly responsible, with other staff members, for such supervision at school functions to which teachers are assigned.
- Model personal and professional commitment to the Gospel values consistent with the goals of the Catholic Church, Diocese and School complying with all Office of Catholic School requirements regarding educational and religious preparation.
- Observe professional ethics and confidentiality in dealing with administrators, faculty, parents, students and community.
- Other duties as assigned.

# **QUALIFICATION GUIDELINES:**

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- Return the completed job application and job questionnaire packets. Copies of transcripts must be submitted with the application.
  Submit three (3) letters of reference to the Office of Catholic Schools. (One should be from immediate past employer
- and one from your pastor).
- Minimum of a BA/BS degree needed for elementary and secondary teaching positions.
- Must either have a California State Credential or provide written evidence of enrollment in the California State Credential program. **PRESCHOOL OR KINDERGARTEN TEACHER**
- Return the completed job application and job questionnaire packets. Copies of transcripts must be submitted with the application.
- Have three (3) letters of reference sent to this office. (One should be from immediate past employer
- and one from your pastor).
- Must have a minimum of 12 semester Early Childhood education units, even if you have a Bachelor's degree. These units must be in Child or human growth and development \* Child, family, and community\* Child and family \* Program and curriculum.

### SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS

- Return the completed job application and job questionnaire packets. Copies of transcripts must be submitted with the application.
- Have three (3) letters of reference sent to this office. (One should be from immediate past employer and one from your pastor).

Candidates receiving an offer of employment must be prepared to submit: a current TB clearance, a record of good health signed by a physician and complete fingerprints by Live Scan for criminal clearance through our agency.
