- Ensures a pastoral approach for all in setting program structures, i.e. Calendar Dates, scheduling use of facilitates procedures for registration, parent orientations and classes, and fee collection.

- Provides continued support for catechists by being present before, during and after teaching assignments.
- Communicates program information to parish community.
- Networks with other catechetical leaders.
- Assists in the planning of liturgical celebrations in the parish.
- Participates in Office for Catechesis and Youth Ministry vicariate meetings and other diocesan meetings as appropriate.
- Takes responsibility for his/her own professional and spiritual development.
- Enrolls in courses and attends workshops related to responsibilities.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualification Requirements:
